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008693816 **SENATE BILL NO. 56** 1 2 Offered January 12, 2000 3 A BILL to amend and reenact § 51.1-124.3 of the Code of Virginia, relating to the Virginia Retirement 4 System. 5 Patron-Trumbo 6 7 Referred to Committee on Finance 8 9 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 1. That § 51.1-124.3 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 10 § 51.1-124.3. Definitions. 11 As used in this chapter, unless the context requires a different meaning: 12 "Abolished system" means the Virginia Refirement Act, §§ 51-30 through 51-111, repealed by 13 14 Chapter 1 of the Acts of Assembly of 1952. "Accumulated contributions" means the sum of all amounts deducted from the compensation of a 15 16 member and credited to his individual account in the member's contribution account, all amounts the member may contribute to purchase creditable service, all member contributions contributed by the 17 employer on behalf of the employee, on or after July 1, 1990, except those amounts contributed on 18 behalf of members of the General Assembly who are otherwise retired under the provisions of this 19 20 chapter, and all interest accruing to these funds. If a member is retired for disability from a cause which 21 is compensable under the Virginia Workers' Compensation Act (§ 65.2-100 et seq.), dies in service prior 22 to retirement, or requests a refund of contributions in accordance with § 51.1-161, "accumulated contributions" shall include all member contributions paid by the employer on behalf of the member on 23 24 and after July 1, 1980, and all interest which would have accrued to these funds. 25 "Actuarial equivalent" means a benefit of equal value when computed upon the basis of actuarial tables adopted by the Board. 26 27 "Average final compensation" means the average annual creditable compensation of a member during 28 his thirty-six highest consecutive months of creditable service or during the entire period of his 29 creditable service if less than thirty-six months. If a member ceased employment prior to July 1, 1974, 30 "average final compensation" means the average annual creditable compensation during the five highest 31 consecutive years of creditable service. "Beneficiary" means any person entitled to receive benefits under this chapter. 32 33 "Board" means the Board of Trustees of the Virginia Retirement System. 34 "Creditable compensation" means the full compensation payable annually to an employee working 35 full time in his covered position and, in the case of teachers, includes all taxable compensation paid to 36 such teachers plus employee elective salary reductions or similar deferral contributions excluded from 37 taxable pay by reason of any elective deferral or contribution permitted by § 415 (c) (3) (D) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. In cases where compensation includes maintenance or 38 39 other perquisites, the Board shall fix the value of that part of the compensation not paid in money. Remuneration received by members of the General Assembly not otherwise retired under the provisions 40 41 of this chapter pursuant to §§ 30-19.11 and 30-19.12 shall be deemed creditable compensation. In addition, for any member of the General Assembly, creditable compensation shall include the full 42 amount of salaries payable to such member for working in covered positions, regardless of whether a 43 contractual salary is reduced and not paid to such member because of service in the General Assembly. 44 "Creditable service" means prior service plus membership service for which credit is allowable. 45 Creditable service may include sick leave credit accumulated as of the employee's retirement date as 46 47 certified by the employer to the Board as set forth in § 51.1-142.1. "Employee" means any teacher, state employee, officer, or employee of a locality participating in the 48 49 Retirement System. 50 "Employer" means the Commonwealth in the case of a state employee, the local public school board 51 in the case of a teacher, or the political subdivision participating in the Retirement System. 52 "Joint Rules Committee" means those members of the House of Delegates and the Senate designated 53 by the Speaker of the House and the Chairman of the Senate Committee on Rules, respectively, to meet 54 with each other and to act jointly on behalf of the Committee on Rules for each house. 55 "Local officer" means the treasurer, commissioner of the revenue, attorney for the Commonwealth, clerk of a circuit court, or sheriff of any county or city, or deputy or employee of any such officer. 56 "Medical Board" means the board of physicians as provided by this chapter. 57

58 "Member" means any person included in the membership of the Retirement System.

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59 "Membership service" means service as an employee rendered while a contributing member of the60 Retirement System except as provided in this chapter.

61 "Normal retirement date" means a member's sixty-fifth birthday.

⁶² "Political subdivision" means any county, city, or town, any political entity, subdivision, branch, or
⁶³ unit of the Commonwealth, or any commission, public authority, or body corporate created by or under
⁶⁴ an act of the General Assembly specifying the powers, privileges, or authority capable of exercise by the
⁶⁵ commission, public authority, or body corporate.

"Primary social security benefit" means, with respect to any member, the primary insurance amount
to which the member is entitled, for old age or disability, as the case may be, pursuant to the provisions
of the federal Social Security Act as in effect at his date of retirement, under the provisions of this
chapter except as otherwise specifically provided.

70 "Prior service" means service rendered prior to becoming a member of the Retirement System.

71 "Retirement allowance" means the retirement payments to which a member is entitled.

- 72 "Retirement System" means the Virginia Retirement System.
- 73 "Service" means service as an employee.

74 "State employee" means any person who is regularly employed full time on a salaried basis, whose 75 tenure is not restricted as to temporary or provisional appointment, in the service of, and whose 76 compensation is payable, no more often than biweekly, in whole or in part, by the Commonwealth or 77 any department, institution, or agency thereof. "State employee" shall include the Governor, Lieutenant 78 Governor, Attorney General, and members of the General Assembly but shall not include (i) any local 79 officer, (ii) any employee of a political subdivision of the Commonwealth, (iii) individuals employed by 79 the Department for the Visually Handicapped pursuant to § 63.1-73, (iv) any member of the State Police

81 Officers' Retirement System, or (v) any member of the Judicial Retirement System.

82 "Teacher" means any person who is regularly employed full time on a salaried basis as a professional83 or clerical employee of a county, city, or other local public school board.
