10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 46.2-726 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 46.2-726. License plates with reserved numbers or letters; fees.
13	The Commissioner may, in his discretion, reserve license plates with certain registration numbers or
14	letters or combinations thereof for issuance to persons requesting license plates so numbered and
15	lettered.
16	License plates with reserved numbers or letters may be issued for and displayed on vehicles operated
17	as ambulances by private ambulance services.
18	The annual fee or, in the case of permanent license plates for trailers and semitrailers, the one-time
19	fee, for the issuance of any license plates with reserved numbers or letters shall be ten dollars plus the
20	prescribed fee for state license plates. If those license plates with reserved numbers or letters are subject
21	to an additional fee beyond the prescribed fee for state license plates, the fee for such special license
22	plates with reserved numbers or letters shall be ten dollars plus the additional fee for the special license
23 24	plates plus the prescribed fee for state license plates.
24 25	The annual fee for reissuing licenses plates with the same combination of letters and numbers as license plates that were previously issued but not renewed shall be ten dollars plus the prescribed fee for
23 26	state license plates. If those license plates are special license plates subject to an additional fee beyond
20 27	the prescribed fee for state license plates, the fee shall be ten dollars plus the additional fee for the
28	special license plates plus the prescribed fee for state license plates.
2 9	License plates with reserved numbers or letters or combinations thereof shall have at least one
30	number or letter and may have as many as eight numbers, letters, or numbers and letters, but no more.
