That § 28.2-1203 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 10 § 28.2-1203. Unlawful use of subaqueous beds; penalty. 11 A. It shall be unlawful for any person to build, dump, trespass or encroach upon or over, or take or 12 13 use any materials from the beds of the bays, ocean, rivers, streams, or creeks which are the property of 14 the Commonwealth, unless such act is performed pursuant to a permit issued by the Commission or is 15 necessary for the following: 1. Erection of dams, the construction of which has been authorized by proper authority; 16 17 2. Uses of subaqueous beds authorized elsewhere in this title; 3. Construction and maintenance of congressionally approved navigation and flood-control projects 18 19 undertaken by the United States Army Corps of Engineers, the United States Coast Guard, or other 20 federal agency authorized by Congress to regulate navigation, navigable waters, or flood control; 4. Construction of piers, docks, marine terminals, and port facilities owned or leased by or to the 21 22 Commonwealth or any of its political subdivisions; or 5. Except as provided in subsection D of § 28.2-1205, placement of private piers for noncommercial 23 24 purposes by owners of the riparian lands in the waters opposite those lands, provided that the piers do 25 not extend beyond the navigation line or private pier lines established by the Commission or the United States Army Corps of Engineers. Subject to any applicable local ordinances, such piers may include an 26 attached boat lift and an open-sided roof designed to shelter a single boat slip or boat lift. In cases in 27 28 which such roofs will exceed 700 square feet in coverage, and in cases in which an adjoining property 29 owner objects to a proposed roof structure, permits shall be required as provided in § 28.2-1204; or 30 6. [ Agricultural, horticultural or silvicultural water use on riparian lands Temporary withdrawals 31 for agricultural, silvicultural and horticultural irrigation on riparian lands, and for watering of animals 32 on riparian lands, provided that no permanent structure is placed on the subaqueous bed ].

**33** B. A violation of this section is a Class 1 misdemeanor.
