That § 46.2-1568 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 11 § 46.2-1568. Coercion of retail dealer by manufacturer or distributor with respect to retail installment 12 sales contracts, financing, or leasing prohibited; penalty. 13 14 A. It shall be unlawful for any manufacturer or distributor, or any officer, agent, or representative of 15 either, to coerce or attempt to coerce any retail motor vehicle dealer or prospective retail motor vehicle 16 dealer in the Commonwealth to sell, assign, or transfer any retail installment sales contract or lease obtained by the dealer in connection with the sale or lease by him in the Commonwealth of motor 17 18 vehicles manufactured or sold by the manufacturer or distributor, to a specified finance company or 19 class of finance companies, leasing company or class of leasing companies, or to any other specified 20 persons by any of the following: 21 1. By any statement, suggestion, promise, or threat that the manufacturer or distributor will in any 22 manner benefit or injure the dealer, whether the statement, suggestion, threat, or promise is express or 23 implied or made directly or indirectly. 24 2. By any act that will benefit or injure the dealer. 25 3. By any contract, or any express or implied offer of contract, made directly or indirectly to the dealer, for handling the motor vehicle on the condition that the dealer sell, assign, or transfer his retail 26 27 installment sales contract on or lease of the vehicle, in the Commonwealth, to a specified finance 28 company or class of finance companies, *leasing company or class of leasing companies*, or to any other 29 specified person. 30 4. By any express or implied statement or representation made directly or indirectly that the dealer is 31 under any obligation whatsoever to sell, assign, or transfer any of his retail sales contracts or leases in 32 the Commonwealth on motor vehicles manufactured or sold by the manufacturer or distributor to a finance company, or class of finance companies, leasing company or class of leasing companies, or 33 34 other specified person, because of any relationship or affiliation between the manufacturer or distributor 35 and the finance company or companies, leasing company or leasing companies, or the specified person 36 or persons. 37 B. Any such statements, threats, promises, acts, contracts, or offers of contracts, when their effect 38 may be to lessen or eliminate competition or tend to create a monopoly, are declared unfair trade 39 practices and unfair methods of competition and are prohibited. C. To further avoid any acts or practices, the effect of which may be to lessen or eliminate 40 41 competition, it shall be unlawful for any manufacturer or distributor, or any officer, agent, or 42 representative thereof, or any person or company affiliated therewith, to condition the provision of lead information to a dealer upon the agreement of the dealer to sell or lease a vehicle to the prospective 43 customer only if the financing or leasing connected with the transaction is effected through a specified 44 45 finance company or class of finance companies or leasing company or class of leasing companies. For the purposes of this section, "lead information" means information concerning a prospective customer 46 who contacts or is contacted by the manufacturer or distributor or any person or company affiliated 47 therewith concerning the manufacturer's or distributor's products. The provisions of this subsection, 48 49 however, shall not prohibit a manufacturer or distributor from so conditioning the provision of lead information concerning any prospective customer who qualifies for any manufacturer-sponsored or 50 51 distributor-sponsored factory employee, factory retiree, or factory vendor new vehicle purchase program. 52 D. Any person found guilty of violating any of the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a 53 Class 1 misdemeanor.

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
