6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 32.1-162.8 of the Code of Virginia, relating to exemptions from
7	licensure of home health organizations.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 32.1-162.8 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 32.1-162.8. Exemptions from article.
11	The provisions of this article shall not be applicable to:
12	1. A natural person, acting alone, who provides services to a patient or individual on an individual
13	basis if such person is (i) licensed to provide such services pursuant to Title 54.1 or (ii) retained by the
14 15	individual or by a person acting on the individual's behalf.
	2. Any organization providing only housekeeping, chore or beautician services.
16	3. Any home care organization located in the Commonwealth which that is:
17	a. Certified by the Department of Health under provisions of Title XVIII or Title XIX of the Social
18	Security Act;
19	b. Approved for payments for home health or personal care by the Department of Medical Assistance
20	Services;
21	c. Accredited by the Joint Commission on Accreditation for Health Organizations, the National
22	League of Nursing or the National Home Caring Council; or

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23 24 25 d. Licensed for hospice services under Article 7 (§ 32.1-162.1 et seq.) of this chapter.
4. Any licensed occupational therapist providing a limited course of specialized activity-of-daily-living therapy that does not exceed five visits under a medical plan of care. Ŋ
