WHEREAS, Sandra Cason graduated from Norfolk State University and earned her master's degree from Old Dominion University; and

WHEREAS, Sandra Cason was a faithful member of New Hope Church of God in Christ and was active in many church activities, including Mass Choir, the Young Adult Choir, and the Wedding Committee; and
