17	WHEREAS, advertising has become a means for governmental agencies of other states to finance
18	their electronic government initiatives and can become a means for governmental agencies in the
19	Commonwealth to finance their electronic government initiatives without undue burden on the citizens
20 21	of the Commonwealth; and WHEREAS, there exist no statewide policies in the Commonwealth regarding advertising on
