Provides that the chief judge or presiding judge of any district court may authorize the clerk's office to close on the basis of a possible threat to the health or safety of office personnel or the general public. In making this determination, coordination with the chief judge or presiding judge of the circuit court should also take place so that both courts take the same action.
