4. **Title** Prohibited ammunition.

5. **Summary/Purpose:** This bill would prohibit the use of nonexpanding types of projectiles or bullets when hunting wild birds or wild animals. A violation of this provision is a Class 3 misdemeanor.

6. **Fiscal Impact:** See Item 8.

7. **Budget amendment necessary:** No

8. **Fiscal implications:** The impact cannot be determined because the number of people who might violate the provisions of the bill is unknown. Any fines for violation of the provisions will be deposited to the Literary Fund. The Department of Game and Inland Fisheries will incur minimal costs associated with court time for each violation.

9. **Specific agency or political subdivisions affected:** Department of Game and Inland Fisheries

10. **Technical amendment necessary:** No

11. **Other comments:** The fine for a Class 3 misdemeanor is not more than \$500.
