4. Title Criminal Justice Services; school resource officers.

5. **Summary/Purpose:** This legislation proposes to amend §9-171.1 of the Code of Virginia to allow the Criminal Justice Services Board to disburse up to five percent of the School Resource Officer Grant Fund for the training of the school resource officers.
6. **Fiscal Impact Estimates are:** Uncertain. See Item 8.
7. **Budget amendment necessary:** None.
8. **Fiscal implications:** The fiscal implications of this legislation are uncertain. Five percent of the School Resource Officer Grant Fund equals approximately \$85,000 annually. This legislation would allow the Criminal Justice Services Board to disburse that amount annually though it does not require that amount be disbursed. Approval of this proposal will reduce the funds available for grants to localities. However, the Department of Criminal Justice Services advises that it is prepared to offer the training that has been identified by localities as necessary for school resource officer programs to be successful.
9. **Specific agency or political subdivisions affected:** Localities and the Department of Criminal Justice Services.
