5. **Summary/Purpose:**

Provides that facilities owned or leased by the state and housing both Department of Motor Vehicles facilities and a general registrar's office may be used as sites for in-person absentee voting. Present law allows in-person absentee voting only in public buildings owned or leased by the county, city, or town.

8. **Fiscal implications:** There may be local costs associated with the code requirement that adequate facilities be provided for the protection of all records and equipment concerning absentee ballots.
