4. **Title** Thermal Imaging Camera Advisory Board and Fund.

5. **Summary/Purpose:** This legislation proposes to amend the Code of Virginia to establish the Thermal Imaging Advisory Board and Camera Fund to assist local fire departments, other fire services organizations and local governments to purchase thermal imaging cameras. The bill also creates a nine member Thermal Imaging Camera Advisory Board to assist the Department of Fire Programs in providing grants to these entities to purchase thermal imaging cameras. Board members will be appointed by the Governor and consist of three members each from the following organizations: the State Fire Chief's Association, the Virginia Professional Firefighters Association, and the Virginia Firefighters Association.

6. **Fiscal Impact Estimates are:** Tentative. See Item 8.

7. **Budget amendment necessary:** Yes. Item 471.

8. **Fiscal implications:** The fiscal implications of this legislation are uncertain. The legislation creates a special non-reverting fund and an advisory board to assist the Department of Fire Programs in providing grants to localities. The legislation further states that the Fund will consist of such funds as appropriated by the General Assembly for this purpose and from such gifts, donations, grants, bequests, and other funds as may be received on its behalf. However, at this time there are no balances in the Fund. This agency has not historically received a significant amount of gifts or donations. Therefore, without additional information regarding the level of funding the General Assembly may provide, the agency is unable to accurately estimate the level of interest by localities or estimate the workload resulting from administering the Fund.
