**4. Title** Temporary registration for certain overseas voters.

**5. Summary/Purpose:**

The bill clarifies that the right to register and continue to vote in state and local elections applies individually to the overseas employee and to the spouse or dependent of that employee who resides with the employee. Amendments to the bill restore the requirement that the voter must have voted at least ones every five years and adds a condition that the provisions will apply retroactively to any voter moving overseas after June 30, 1999.
