5. **Summary/Purpose:** This bill would add parents of a landowner to the list of those who can hunt, trap, and fish within the boundaries of the landowner's property or fish upon any private permanent extension from such property.

8. **Fiscal implications:** While the fiscal impact of this bill is slight, license sales are shrinking 1-3 percent per year and any revenue reduction further escalates a diminishing revenue base for the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries, a specially funded agency.
