11. **Other comments:** The General Assembly or the Commonwealth Transportation Board has the statutory authority to name Highways and Bridges that form a part of the systems of State Highways.

Mr. Everett H. Hogge, who passed away on April 4, 1988, was a member of the General Assembly representing the 93rd House District.

Mr. Hogge served on the Newport News City Planning Commission from 1984 to 1988.

State Route 306 (Harpersville Road) is located between U.S. Route 60 and U.S. Route 17 in the City of Newport News. That portion of Harpersville Road between Augusta Drive and Longmeadow Drive as requested to be named by this bill is not part of State Route 306.

This bill should be amended to relocate the designation to State Route 306 thereby making it eligible to be named by the General Assembly.

Cost to VDOT includes the fabrication and installation of two signs. The bill as written would differ from the Commonwealth Transportation Board's practice of requiring an affected locality of localities to pay for the fabrication and installation of signs for naming a highway or bridge.
