4. Title Information Providers Network Authority; powers and duties.

5. Summary/Purpose:

Legislation clarifies that state agencies and local governments, which currently have statutory authority to contract with the Virginia Information Providers Network Authority (Authority) for use of the Authority's facilities and Authority's services, may pay for such use and services. Provides that the Authority may fix and collect fees for such use and services, and further clarifies that state funds may not be used for the Authority's purposes except as provided by the Code of Virginia.

8. Fiscal implications: None; this bill simply clarifies ambiguities and contradictions in the current code in order to affirm the Authority's current practices in reviewing and approving agreements with state agencies.
