4. **Title** Combined precinct registered voter list and pollbook.

5. **Summary/Purpose:**

Extends from July 1, 2001, to July 1, 2002, the time for the State Board of Elections to conduct pilot programs to test the use of one list that combines the functions of the registered voter list and pollbook. The bill requires the Board to report its evaluation of the pilot programs to the General Assembly prior to the 2002 Regular Session.
