5. Summary/Purpose:

Requires counties that cancel secondary system highway construction, or improvement projects included in their six-year plans, to reimburse the Commonwealth Transportation Board (CTB) for funds expended for planning, engineering, right-of-way acquisition, demolition, relocation, and construction. The bill also allows the CTB to waive the reimbursement and or deposit the recovered funds into the secondary road allocation of the county that cancelled the project.

8. Fiscal implications: This legislation will allow the Commonwealth Transportation Board (CTB) to recover costs from counties that request projects to be cancelled after funds have been expended on the project. This change provides the same requirements as presently placed on cities.
