5. Summary/Purpose: The bill would provide that the requirement that owners of confined animal feeding operations notify neighboring property owners prior to applying for coverage under a general permit would be waived whenever the registration is for the purpose of renewing coverage under a permit for which no expansion is proposed and the Department of Environmental Quality has not issued any special or consent order relating to violations under the existing permit.
