5. Summary/Purpose:

This bill modifies the retirement allowance paid under the Virginia Law Officers' Retirement System ("VaLORS) by increasing from 1.7% to 2.0% the percentage of average final compensation multiplied by the years of creditable service in a position covered under VaLORS, the State Police Officers Retirement System (SPORS) or special benefits for law enforcement officers and firefighters (LEOS/FIRE), and by deleting the supplemental allowance currently paid to members upon retirement until age sixty-five (currently \$9,264 annually). The bill applies to employees who become members of VaLORS on or after July 1, 2001, and to current employees who elect to accept the modifications by October 31, 2001. The Senate substitute proposed by the Committee on Courts of Justice changes the period during which the \$9,264 monthly State Police Officers Retirement System (SPORS) supplement (currently \$772/month) is paid. The supplement is currently paid from retirement until age 65. This Senate substitute changes the payment period to retirement until the member reaches eligibility for full retirement under the Social Security Act. By reference, the substitute also extends the period for payment of the supplement to local employees covered under special benefits for law enforcement officer and firefighters (LEOS/FIRE).
