4. Title Council on Human Resources.

5. Summary/Purpose:

Merges the Personnel Advisory Board, the State Health Benefits Advisory Council, the Virginia Equal Employment Opportunity Council and consolidates their functions in the Virginia Council on Human Resources. The bill increases the number of members from 12 to 17 and requires that 8 members be appointed by the Governor, four members appointed by the House and three members appointed by the Senate. In addition, the Directors of the Departments of Human Resource Management and Dispute Resolution shall serve permanently as ex officio without voting privileges.

6. No Fiscal Impact

7. Budget amendment necessary: No

8. Fiscal implications: This bill combines several existing human resources-related bodies that currently advise the Department of Human Resource Management (DHRM) into one council. This bill should not create an additional burden on the budget of DHRM which pays the expenses of these advisory bodies.

11. Other comments: This bill is similar to SB 1140 which has also passed both houses.
