5.	Summary/Purpose:		
	This bill provides that payments made to tobacco farmers from the Tobacco Indemnification and		
	Community Revitalization (TICR) Fund shall not be transferable or assignable, except in certain		
	circumstances such as part of a property settlement agreement. The bill also (i) prohibits grants,		
	loans or other distributions paid from the Fund to promote economic growth and development from		

Community Revitalization Commission.

Amendments to the bill remove the prohibition to appeal a determination of erroneous payment made

being subject to execution, levy, attachment, garnishment or other legal process, (ii) authorizes the Commission to recover payments erroneously made from the Fund, (iii) provides time limitations regarding applications for indemnification payments, and (iv) adds confidentiality provisions relating

to certain personal and financial information provided to the Tobacco Indemnification and

by the Commission and makes any determination subject to judicial or administrative review.
