- **5. Summary/Purpose:** The bill addresses a regulatory requirement of VAC 5-410 of the *Virginia Administrative Code* (the regulations governing hospitals) that requires emergency telephone and other verbal orders to be authenticated within 24 hours of the time that they are given. This bill allows hospitals to develop their own protocols determining when verbal orders must be authenticated and by whom, if the ordering physician is not available to sign the orders.
