8.	Fiscal implications: The fiscal impact of the proposed legislation is not known. Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University reports an average annual subsidy of approximately \$135,000 to maintain airport operations. With the participation of the three localities in the operation of the airport, the university's costs should be reduced significantly. However, a memorandum of understanding will have to be agreed upon before the actual extent of the university's financial obligation will be known. In addition, it is anticipated that the airport will be able to expend its operations and generate additional revenue to support its operations.
