4. Title Virginia Tech/Montgomery Regional Airport Authority.

5. Summary/Purpose: Establishes the Virginia Tech/Montgomery Regional Airport Authority and provides for the powers of the Authority and the responsibilities of the participating members of the Authority.

- 6. Fiscal Impact: See Item 8.
- 7. Budget amendment necessary: No.
- 8. Fiscal implications: The fiscal impact of the proposed legislation is not known. Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University report an average annual subsidy of approximately \$135,000 to maintain airport operations. It is anticipated that this subsidy will be reduced by seventy-five percent since three other parties are to join the authority and share proportionately with fiscal responsibilities. Another potential impact regards sharing decision-making with three other entities. Decisions could be made by the other three entities that result in a potential increase in debt burden for Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University (e.g., issue bonds to expand airport functions).
- 9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected: Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University, Town of Blacksburg, Town of Christiansburg, County of Montgomery.
- 10. Technical amendment necessary: Yes. The substitute bill is missing the word "enter" on page 2, line 96, after the word "shall."
- 11. Other comments: Similar to SB1170.
