4. Title Veterans Care Center.

5. Summary/Purpose:

Authorizes the Virginia Veterans Care Center Board of Trustees to govern and oversee the administration of any additional facilities that may be established for the care of Virginia veterans. Current law limits the Board's authority to the Virginia Veterans Care Center.

6. No significant fiscal impact

7. Budget amendment necessary: No

8. Fiscal implications: This bill would allow the Board of Trustees of the current Veterans Care Center in Roanoke to also oversee any other veterans care centers to be built in the future, including the new veterans care center scheduled to open in Richmond. That new center is now in the planning stages.

Should the board need to hold additional meetings in order to also oversee an additional facility, some minor additional costs for travel expenses of board members might be incurred, but these additional costs would be minimal.

9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected: The bill affects the Virginia Veterans Care Center Board of Trustees. It also affects the Department of Veterans' Affairs, which is responsible for the construction of the new veterans care center planned for Richmond.
