5.	Summary/Purpose: The bill prohibits a person from possessing a hydraulic dredge in Virginia waters. The penalty for possessing this type of equipment is a Class 1 misdemeanor.			
6.	Fiscal Impact Estimates are unknown at this time			
7.	Budget amendment necessary: No			
8.	Fiscal implications: Sentencing for a Class 1 misdemeanor could include jail time. There is not enough information available to reliably estimate how may convictions and prisoner in jail could result from the bill. Any increase in jail population will increase costs to the state. The Commonwealth pays the localities \$8 a day for each misdemeanant held in a jail, and the state also provides support for local jail operations. This support averaged \$30.54 per inmate each day in FY 1999.
