**4. Title** Management of the Commonwealth's central vehicle fleet.

**5. Summary/Purpose:**

Transfers from the Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner to the Director of the Department of General Services the responsibility for managing the Commonwealth's central vehicle fleet. This transfer, however, is inapplicable to the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT); VDOT will continue to control its own vehicle fleet.

**6. No Fiscal Impact**

**7. Budget amendment necessary:** A budget amendment will be needed to effect the transfer in HB 1600 and SB 800 to transfer to the Department of General Services and transfer from the Department of Transportation.

**8. Fiscal implications:** There are no fiscal implications with this transfer. This legislation will eliminate the management and control of Program 823, Transportation Pool Services, from VDOT and transfer management and control of the program to the Department of General Services. The revenue for this program is derived solely from rental rates paid for the use of fleet vehicles.

**9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected:** The Department of General Services and the Department of Transportation.
