5. **Summary/Purpose:** This bill establishes a lifetime trapping license for veterans who have a service-connected disability and persons who are permanently disabled. The fee for such a license would be five dollars.

8. **Fiscal implications:** The revenue projection assumes the issuance of 100 licenses in FY 2002 and 200 licenses in FY 2003. While the fiscal impact of this bill is slight, license sales are shrinking between one and three percent per year and further reduces a declining license revenue base for the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries, a specially funded agency.
