4. Title Establish lifetime trapping license for disabled persons

5. Summary/Purpose: This bill establishes a lifetime trapping license for veterans who have a service-connected disability and persons who are permanently disabled. The fee for such a license would be five dollars.

7. Budget amendment necessary: No

8. Fiscal implications: The revenue impact of this bill is minimal (<\$3,000> in FY 2002, and <\$6,000> in FY 2003) and will have no impact on the operations of the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries. This estimate assumes the issuance of 100 licenses in FY 2002 and 200 licenses in FY 2003. License sales are shrinking between one and three percent per year.
