5. **Summary/Purpose:**

Requires the Joint Legislative Audit and Review Commission to provide by November 15 of each year to the Governor and the General Assembly a report on state spending, in seven categories.

The enrolled bill broadens the scope of the introduced bill by adding tax relief measures and mandated expenditures to the factors to be considered in analyzing growth in spending as well as any other related matter.

6. **No Fiscal Impact**

The Joint Legislative Audit and Review Commission reports that it can implement this requirement with current staff and appropriations by realigning staff and rescheduling projects.
