4. Title Workers' compensation; includes ABC special agents.

5. Summary/Purpose:

Presumption as to death or disability from hypertension or heart disease for special agents (law enforcement personnel) of the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control. Extends the presumption for work-related death or disability from hypertension or heart disease under workers' compensation to include special agents of the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control.

8. Fiscal implications: The number of possible claims are unknown. Based on known percentages of claims versus number of positions with other eligible law enforcement agencies, it is estimated that approximately one or two ABC agents could possibly file a claim. The average cost per claim is approximately \$100,000. The total cost would depend entirely on the number of claims filed and approved for payment.
