4. Title Lists of registered voters and persons voting; voter registration applications

5. Summary/Purpose:

Expands the list of protective orders that qualify a voter so protected to provide a post office box address to be used in lieu of his street address on the lists sold by the State Board. The bill also gives the State Board discretion to furnish the post office box address, in lieu of the street address, on other lists and reports to protect the street address information for persons with protective orders and certain law-enforcement officials.
