4. Title Issuance of Governor's warrant of arrest.

5. Summary/Purpose:

Provides that any electronically transmitted Governor's warrant of arrest shall be treated as an original document, if subsequently, the original is received within four days of the electronic copy. This legislation does not require electronic means be used, only that if used, an electronic copy should be accepted as an original would. Additionally, even a facsimile copy could be used rather than any type of Internet transmittal.

7. Fiscal implications:

As this proposal will reduce or eliminate the dependence upon state troopers for making courier deliveries of warrants, a savings can be expected from the reduced fuel needs of the State Police. However, it is not expected to be a substantial impact and without further, in-depth analysis, the exact savings cannot be determined.
