- **8. Fiscal implications:** If VDOT assesses penalties it will generate revenue. The exact amount of revenue generated from these penalties will depend on the number and type of environmental violations.

For example, this year an estimated 700 projects will be initiated by VDOT. If we assume one half or 350 of these projects have the potential for environmental violations, the levied fines would generate revenue that would depend on the number and severity of the violations.

The specific types of violations and related fines will need to be developed by VDOT with the passage of this bill.
