4. Title Motor vehicles; license fees.

5. Summary/Purpose:

Motor vehicles; license fees. Permits localities to charge an additional license fee of no more than one dollar on motor vehicles. The funds from such fees must be paid into the Volunteer Firefighters' and Rescue Squad Workers' Pension Fund ("Fund"). The legislation clarifies that contributions to the Fund by a locality must be made on behalf of all members of the Fund who are volunteers for fire departments or rescue squads within the jurisdiction of the locality. Similarly, the legislation clarifies that contributions to the Fund by a fire department or rescue squad must be made on behalf of all members of the Fund within the particular fire department or rescue squad. For companion bill, see HB 1679 (Tate).

8. Fiscal implications: This bill allows a locality to determine whether or not to participate by implementing an increase in the motor vehicle license tax of up to a dollar. This increase would be assessed on every vehicle registered in that locality.
