5. Summary/Purpose: Legislation allows clerks and deputy clerks of general district courts to perform notarial acts and exempts the courts from the notary public application fee.

Fiscal implications: There are no direct costs to the courts since this legislation grants the courts an exemption from the customary notary public application fee paid to the Secretary of the Commonwealth. If the clerks perform notarial acts only in their official capacity for the courts, then no loss of revenue should be anticipated for the Secretary of the Commonwealth.
