Summary/Purpose: This bill adds the Roanoke Higher Education Authority and Center (RHEA) to the list in §23-14 of the <i>Code of Virginia</i> designating educational institutions declared to be public bodies and constituted as governmental instrumentalities for the dissemination of education. The Virginia College Building Authority uses this listing to determine which institutions are eligible for allocations under the Higher Education Equipment Trust Fund. This measure would make RHEA eligible to receive such allocations.

8. Fiscal implications: This bill adds RHEA to the list of institutions eligible for Equipment Trust Fund support. However, it does not allocate funds to the RHEA, and does not require that funds be allocated in the future.
