4. **Title** Abuse and neglect of incapacitated adults

5. **Summary/Purpose:**

Currently, abuse or neglect of an incapacitated adult is punishable as a Class 1 misdemeanor unless (i) there has been a prior conviction for abuse or neglect, or (ii) the abuse or neglect results in serious bodily injury or disease. In either of the latter two circumstances, the offense is punishable as a Class 6 felony. The proposed legislation does not change these provisions, but clarifies them.

8. **Fiscal implications:**

Because the legislation does not make any substantive change in the existing law, it is not expected to have any impact on prison bed space.
