4. Title Subaqueous permit exemption

5. Summary/Purpose: The bill exempts withdrawals for agricultural, horticultural, and silvicultural irrigation on riparian lands, or for watering of animals on riparian lands, from requiring a permit issued by the Virginia Marine Resources Commission for use of subaqueous beds, provided that no permanent structure is placed on the subaqueous beds, requirements administered by the Department of Environmental Quality under Title 62.1 are met, and the activity does not create adverse impacts to instream beneficial uses as defined in § 62.1-10.
