**4. Title** Practice of nursing

**5. Summary/Purpose:** Exempts, for ninety days from the date of approval of an application submitted to the Board, any nurse who is a graduate of a foreign nursing school and has met the credential, language, and academic testing requirements of the Commission on Graduates of Foreign Nursing Schools when such nurse is working as a non-supervisory staff nurse in a licensed nursing home or certified nursing facility. During such six-month period, such nurse must take and pass the licensing examination to remain eligible to practice nursing in Virginia; no exemption granted under this subdivision can be extended.
