4. Title Incorporation of regulations and amendments by local ordinances.

5. Summary/Purpose:

Provides that when localities are empowered to incorporate by reference state regulations into a local ordinance, any ordinance incorporating by reference state regulations may include future amendments to the state regulations provided such intent is specifically stated in such ordinance. The same authority already exists with regard to state statutes.

6. No Fiscal Impact

7. Budget amendment necessary: No

8. Fiscal implications: The bill has no fiscal implications for state agencies. It will reduce the need for localities to revise local ordinances that reference state regulations if those state regulations change. To the extent that any costs are associated with adoption or revision of local ordinances, the bill could reduce costs for localities.
