4. Title Agricultural cooperative associations; forfeiture of equity

5. Summary/Purpose: This bill authorizes the bylaws and member agreements of an agricultural cooperative association to provide that when the agricultural cooperative association holds any membership or patronage equity to the credit of a person who has not had a correct address on file for at least three years, such equity is forfeited to the association. If there is no such provision in the association's bylaws or member agreements, or if there is no publication, then the Uniform Disposition of Unclaimed Property Act shall apply.

Such funds are presently collected by the State Treasurer, transferred to the Literary Fund and held in perpetuity for owners. The negative revenue impact is based on funds received from such cooperatives currently.
