5.	Summary/Purpose: This bill provides that retired persons who are members of the Virginia Retirement System may be hired as teachers without interrupting their retirement benefits. This bill applies to licensed instructional personnel who have been (i) retired for at least one year from employment with a Virginia local school board before returning to the classroom on a full-time basis; (ii) licensed to teach in the Commonwealth; and (iii) hired on an annual contract basis and ineligible for continuing contract status.

8. Fiscal implications: In considering the full impact of this bill, we anticipate non-material losses to the System due to the eligibility of employees to be rehired after retirement under this bill. Since the bill requires a twelve-month waiting period, we do not feel this would provide a significant enticement for members to retire earlier. Therefore, we foresee no significant change in the retirement patterns of those eligible to retire and therefore no material impact to the System.
