11	WHEREAS, since May of 1999, the Commonwealth Transportation Board, the Virginia Department
12	of Transportation and the Town of West Point have been researching several options for replacement of
13	the bridges in the Town of West Point; and
14 15	WHEREAS, after various meetings and hearings, the Commonwealth Transportation Board and the Virginia Department of Transportation concluded that the best option would be for the downtown
16	bridges to be replaced (Alternative B-2); and
17	WHEREAS, many citizens of West Point and the surrounding area favor another option: construction
18	of a northern bypass (Alternative A); and
19	WHEREAS, the efforts of the Town of West Point, its citizens, and residents of the surrounding area
20	have failed to persuade the Commonwealth Transportation Board of the Virginia Department of
21	Transportation to reconsider its opposition to construction of the northern bypass alternative; and
22	WHEREAS neither the Commonwealth Transportation Board nor the Virginia Department of
23	Transportation have been willing to afford any opportunity for further hearings to be held concerning
24 25	this matter; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That it is the sense of the General
23 26	Assembly that the Commonwealth Transportation Board and the Virginia Department of Transportation
20 27	revisit their decision to replace the downtown bridges in the Town of West Point, with consideration
28	being given to construction of a northern bypass; and, be it

RESOLVED FURTHER That the Clerk of the House of Delegates transmit copies of this resolution
to the Virginia Secretary of Transportation and the Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner in
order that they may be apprised of the sense of the General Assembly in this matter.
