10	WHEREAS, the Hampton Roads Third Crossing Bridge-Tunnel Commission was created by House
11	Joint Resolution No. 125, approved by the 2000 Regular Session of the General Assembly; and
12	WHEREAS, events unforeseen at the time of the approval of HJR 125 (2000), make it desirable and
13	practical to increase the membership of that Commission beyond its original composition through the

addition of one member of the Senate; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the membership of the Hampton Roads Third Crossing Bridge-Tunnel Commission, established by House Joint Resolution No. 125 of the 2000 Regular Session be increased to allow the appointment of a total of five members of the Senate to the Commission, rather than the four members of the Senate provided for in HJR 125. Such additional member shall be appointed by the Senate Committee on Privileges and Elections, giving due consideration to members of the Senate who had prior service on the Commission as members of the House of Delegates.
