

# VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY -- 2002 SESSION

## CHAPTER 209

*An Act to amend and reenact § 9.1-162 of the Code of Virginia, relating to crime prevention specialists.*

**Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

**1. That § 9.1-162 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

§ 9.1-162. Eligibility for crime prevention specialists.

Any employee of a ~~local or state law-enforcement agency~~ shall be *local, state or federal government agency who serves in a law-enforcement, crime prevention or criminal justice capacity* is eligible to be trained and certified as a crime prevention specialist.

The chief executive of any ~~local or state law-enforcement~~ *local, state or federal government* agency may designate one or more employees in his department or office, *who serves in a law-enforcement, crime prevention or criminal justice capacity*, to be trained and certified as a crime prevention specialist.
