6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 15.2-1534 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 15.2-1534. Certain officers not to hold more than one office.

9 A. Pursuant to Article VII, Section 6 of the Constitution of Virginia, no person holding the office of
10 treasurer, sheriff, attorney for the Commonwealth, clerk of the circuit court, commissioner of the
11 revenue, supervisor, councilman, mayor, board chairman, or other member of the governing body of any
12 locality shall hold more than one such office at the same time.

13 B. Subsection A shall not be construed to prohibit:

14 1. A commissioner of the revenue of a county from serving as appointed commissioner of the
15 revenue of a town located in the county;

16 2. A treasurer of a county from serving as appointed treasurer of a town located in the county;

17 3. A deputy sheriff of a county from serving as appointed town sergeant of a town located in the
18 county;

19 4. A person from serving simultaneously as an assistant attorney for the Commonwealth in the City
20 of Winchester and Frederick County;

21 5. A person from serving as attorney for the Commonwealth for Bland County and assistant attorney
22 for the Commonwealth of Wythe County; ~~or~~

23 6. The election of deputies of constitutional officers to school board membership, consistent with
24 federal law and regulation; *or*

25 7. *A person from serving simultaneously as a part-time assistant attorney for the Commonwealth in*
26 *more than one locality with the consent of the respective attorneys for the Commonwealth and the*
27 *Compensation Board in accordance with procedures adopted by the Compensation Board.*
