The governing body of any locality may appoint such advisory boards, committees, and commissions 14 15 as it deems necessary to advise the governing body with regard to any matter of concern to the locality. Members shall be appointed to serve at the pleasure of the governing body. 16 17

Members shall be appointed to serve at the pleasure of the governing body.

The governing body may provide for (i) reimbursement of the actual expenses incurred by members while serving on such advisory boards, committees, and commissions and (ii) compensation to members for their services not to exceed fifty seventy-five dollars for attendance per meeting at regularly scheduled meetings, not to exceed one meeting per month, and for training in an amount determined

appropriate by the governing body from available funds.
