13	46.2-746.4:3, and 46.2-749.46 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows:
14	§ 46.2-740. Special license plates for survivors of Battle of Chosin Reservoir; fees.
15	On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a survivor of the Battle of
16	Chosin Reservoir, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to the applicant.
17 18	For each set of license plates issued under this section, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition to the prescribed cost of state license plates a one time for of ten dollars at the time the plates are
10 19	to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of ten dollars at the time the plates are issued.
20	The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license
21	plates issued under this section.
22	§ 46.2-742.2. Special license plates for persons awarded the Navy Cross, the Distinguished Service
23 24	Cross, the Air Force Cross, or the Distinguished Flying Cross; fees. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant has been awarded the Navy
24 25	Cross, the Distinguished Service Cross, the Air Force Cross, or the Distinguished Flying Cross, the
26	Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates.
27	For each set of license plates issued under this section, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition
28	to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of ten dollars at the time the plates are
29 30	<i>issued.</i> The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license
30 31	plates issued under this section.

35 36	A. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is an honorably discharged former member of one of the armed forces of the United States, the Commissioner shall issue to the
37	applicant special license plates.
38	B. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is on active duty with, has
39	been honorably discharged after at least six months of active duty service in, or has retired from the
40	United States Marine Corps, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates whose
41 42	design incorporates an emblem of the United States Marine Corps. C. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of World War II,
43	the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of World War II.

59 § 46.2-746.1. Special license plates for members of military assault forces; fees.

60 On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is or has been, while serving in the armed forces of the United States, a member of a military assault force, the Commissioner shall 61 62 issue to the applicant special license plates. For the purposes of this section, a military assault force is a 63 unit or element of the armed forces of the United States engaged in or charged with the invasion or 64 capture of territory under the control of enemy forces.

65 For each set of license plates issued under this section, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of ten dollars at the time the plates are 66 67 issued.

The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license 68 69 plates issued under this section. 70

§ 46.2-746.2:1. Special license plates; members of the 82nd Airborne Division Association; fees.

71 On receipt of an application therefor and presentation of written evidence that the applicant is a 72 member of the 82nd Airborne Division Association, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant 73 special license plates.

74 For each set of license plates issued under this section, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition 75 to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of ten dollars at the time the plates are 76 issued.

§ 46.2-746.2:2. Special license plates; members of the Society of the 173rd Airborne Brigade; fees.

78 On receipt of an application therefor and presentation of written evidence that the applicant is a 79 member of the Society of the 173rd Airborne Brigade, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant 80 special license plates.

81 For each set of license plates issued under this section, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition 82 to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of ten dollars at the time the plates are 83 issued. 84

§ 46.2-746.4. Special license plates for members of certain military veterans' organizations; fees.

85 On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a member of any of the following military veterans' organizations, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to the 86 members of the following organizations: the American Legion, the Disabled American Veterans, the 87 88 Legion of Valor of the USA, the Marine Corps League, the Retired Officers Association, the Special 89 Forces Association, the Veterans of the Battle of Iwo Jima, and the Vietnam Veterans of America.

90 For each set of license plates issued under this section, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition 91 to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of ten dollars at the time the plates are 92 issued.

93 The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates issued to members of the Legion of Valor of the USA under this section. 94

95 § 46.2-746.4:3. Special license plates for submarine service veterans; fees.

On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a submarine service veteran, 96 the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to submarine service veterans. 97

98 For each set of license plates issued under this section, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition 99 to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of ten dollars at the time the plates are 100 issued.

101 § 46.2-749.46. Special license plates; naval aviators; fees.

102 On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is or has been a naval aviator, 103 the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates.

104 For each set of license plates issued under this section, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition

to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of ten dollars at the time the plates are 105 106 issued.
